Venue:

The Lights Sports and Community Centre, 244 - 270 East Parkway, Lightsvue

Team, Results, Draw & Rules Information:

- **Scorers & game times**

- Each team will need to supply an Independent scorer (this cannot be a coach or bench player) and both scorers will need to:
- Sit and score the match together and fill out **ONE** score sheet and operate a scoreboard between them for the match.
- Then confirm the scores and have the team coaches signing the score sheet.
- Score sheets will need to be brought to the SACSA desk as soon as the game is finished.
- Games will be 7 mins Quarters, with 1 min breaks and 2 mins between games for warm up time/change over. Altogether 35 mins.
- Teams change ends each quarter.
- A siren will signal for the finish of 1/4 and 3/4-time breaks, halftime and end of the game.
- No time outs.
- Each team will need to be at the court they are playing on at least five minutes before their game commences.

- **The Team**

- Max of 7 players on court at any one time & up to 3 reserves (**10 players max**).
- **Substitutions** can only be made during the quarter-time breaks or at half-time. Not during any time of play.
- There is no limit on the number of substitutions that can be made during these times.

- **Ball and Ring Height Information**

- **size 5** Netball
- SACSA will supply all match balls
- Only bring 2 named balls per team from your school to practice with.
- Ring height will be standard Height 3.05m (10ft)

- **Start of the game**

- The **Home** team on the **score sheet** shall: Take the first Centre Pass.
- The **Away team** to choose goal end. Then to take the first second half Centre Pass.

- **Table Points:**

- 3 points for a win, 2 points for a draw, 1 point for a loss.



- **In the event of a draw** during the minor rounds there will be NO extra time played.
- **FINALS DRAW:**
 - The **top two teams will progress to the Grand Final** after the minor round matches
 - Please check the sportfix app for all updates. Finals tab
 - Should two or more teams finish on equal points then the following method will be used to determine final positions in the order below:
 - i. The result** of the match between the teams (Head-to-Head) concerned.
 - ii.** If still tied or more than two teams tied, placing's determined by the **highest goal percentage** e.g. goals scored for / goals scored against x 100.
 - iii.** If still tied, the team with the least amount of points scored against them.
- **In the event of a draw during Grand Finals:**
 - Extra time will be a two-minute period.
 - Teams will keep to the same end as they were in the second half.
 - The teams have 30 seconds to sub if needed. All students still playing must stay on court and go back to centre pass position immediately.
 - The game will start again with the next in turn centre pass.
 - Clock will not stop during Extra time.
 - If tied after two minutes, sudden death with first team scoring, wins the game.
- **RULES**
 - Rules will be in accordance with the International Rules of Netball.
As well as -
SACSA Sports Highlighted and or Modified RULES
 - A defending player may not:
 - a) Cause the goal post to move so as to interfere with a shot on goal.
 - b) Deflect a ball on its downward flight towards the ring, including touching the ball up through the net.
Sanction (for a & b): Penalty shot/pass. If a shot is successful, the goal is scored.
Defend the player not the goal.
- **Uniforms**
 - Please make sure you bring Netball bibs and if you can 2 sets as this allows for easier transfer of substitutions during the game or for a clash of colours.
